

CGG Commences 7700 km² Foz do Amazonas 3D Seismic Reimaging Project of Existing Public Data

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CGG has announced the start of a new Foz do Amazonas 3D seismic reimaging project, aimed at supporting Brazil's Permanent Offer initiative in the Equatorial Margin. The project, supported by industry funding, is expected to complete by the end of 2023, with fast-track products available by June.

The reimaging project will merge over 7700 km² of existing public 3D seismic data in the Foz do Amazonas basin. The area has a rich network of turbiditic fans and channels made attractive by its geologic proximity to Guyana and Suriname and the recent success stories along the South Atlantic conjugate margins of West Africa.

Dechun Lin, EVP, Earth Data, said: "The Foz do Amazonas 3D reimaging project will benefit from our in-depth knowledge of the Equatorial Margin and further expand our 3D data library offshore Brazil, which is already the most comprehensive in the industry.
