Conditions for availability or consultation of information relating to AXA's Ordinary and Extraordinary Shareholders' Meeting of April 23, 2024

AXA's Shareholders' Meeting will take place on Tuesday April 23, 2024 at 2:30 pm (Paris time) at the Salle Pleyel – 252 rue du Faubourg Saint Honoré – 75008 Paris - France.

The shareholders' Notice of Meeting including among other items the agenda, the resolutions submitted by the Board of Directors and the conditions for participation and exercise of voting rights can be found on AXA's website at the following address: www.axa.com under the "Investors / Individual Shareholders / Shareholders' Meetings" section.

Among the resolutions presented to shareholders for approval will be a proposed dividend of €1.98 per share. If approved by shareholders, the dividend will be paid on May 6, 2024 with an ex-dividend date of April 30, 2024.

In 2023, IFRS revenues amounted to Euro 102.7 billion and underlying earnings to Euro 7.6 billion. AXA had Euro 946 billion in assets under management as of December 31, 2023.

The AXA ordinary share is listed on compartment A of Euronext Paris under the ticker symbol CS (ISN FR 0000120628 – Bloomberg: CS FP – Reuters: AXAF.PA). AXA's American Depository Share is also quoted on the OTC QX platform under the ticker symbol AXAHY.

The AXA Group is included in the main international SRI indexes, such as Dow Jones Sustainability Index (DJSI) and FTSE4GOOD.

It is a founding member of the UN Environment Programme's Finance Initiative (UNEP FI) Principles for Sustainable Insurance and a signatory of the UN Principles for Responsible Investment.
